- In 2006, KSR launched operations in Auckland, New Zealand. KSR operates in more than 100 locations worldwide – Australia, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, France, Germany, India, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Puerto Rico, Singapore, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, United Kingdom, and the United States.
- In 2001, KSR acquired Search Masters International, a scientific and executive search firm with an industry focus on the biotechnology and pharmaceutical fields.
- Established in 2000, KSR's Future Scientist Program helps connect entry-level science students with jobs, internships and research opportunities at major chemical, pharmaceutical, and biotech companies in the United States.
- In May 1999, KSR entered the Australian market through the acquisition of Labstaff, the longest-established scientific staffing company in Australia. KSR is now Australia's largest scientific staffing company with offices in Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, and Perth.
- In 1998, Kelly was the first staffing company to launch an interactive, web-based training product, The Scientific Learning Center, which offers more than 1,200 scientific and continuing education courses to professionals in today's workforce.
